The Training Facility offers Advanced training , Professional development courses and Continuing education training to its members. Last year we trained six times more Journeyman than apprentices.

Some of our Journeyman refresher courses include (Pipe bending, Motors and Controls, Variable Frequency Drives, Fire Alarm and Programmable Logic Controllers), specialty classes in (confined space training, OSHA 10 and 30, foreman training, code of excellence), a College degree program (Community College Of Rhode Island degree in Electrical technologies)

We offer our member apprentices, journeyman and sister Locals a Nationally recognized Skills and Craft performance training, testing and certification Facility with Nationally recognized teachers and instructors

Our Nationally accredited Craft Level Certification Testing and Examination facility evaluates and certifies an Electricians knowledge and ability level. (a must for organizing)

Special training classes are being held every Friday night and individualized instruction is available for those who need / want to develop or improve their abilities.

In our computer lab we offer journeyman NJATC on- line courses



We currently offer to our apprentices a five year curriculum including,

Commercial wiring, theory and hands on techniques

as well as renewable energy technology

Students who graduate from our program are awarded 45 college credits toward their degree at participating Rhode Island Colleges.

Local 99 apprentices can also join Skills USA the second largest student organization in the country and compete in both Local and National Skills USA competition opportunities in Residential and Industrial Motor Controls

### Qualifications

- Must be 18 years of age at time of selection
- Have a high school diploma or GED certificate.
- Must meet or exceed Math requirements. Successfully pass One full year of Algebra (accepted by college).
- Provide an official transcript from high school or Department of Education.
- Submit DD-214 to verify military training and or other experience for consideration.
- Have a qualifying score on the electrical trade aptitude test, developed and validated by the American Institute for Research.
- Possess and maintain a valid drivers license.
- Have the legal right to work in United States
