When, Where and How to get there...

When? Sunday, August 9, 2026 11:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

Where? Kempenaar's Clambake Club Route 214 (Valley Road) Middletown, RI

How To Get There: (Directions)

Driving from Providence area:

Take Route 195 East to Route 24 South in Fall River. Route 24 takes you back into RI and joins with Route 138, which takes you into Middletown toward Newport. Take a left at the stoplight onto Route 214 (Valley Road). *Beware, if you pass the Newport Creamery on your right on 138 you weren't paying attention to signs.* Once on Rt. 214, approximately 1 mile on your right, you will turn at the (KCC) Kempenaar's Clambake Club sign.

OR...

You can go Route 95 South onto Route 138 over the Newport Bridge, past Newport Grand. Take left after exit and drive straight until you reach intersection of Rt. 214, then turn left onto Route 214 (Valley Rd.) at stoplight. Kempenaar's will be on your left.

Driving from Boston area:

Take Route 24 South which joins with Route 138 into Middletown. Turn left at stoplight onto Route 214 (Valley Road) traveling approximately one mile to KCC sign on right.

Driving from New Haven / New York:

Take Route 95 North and get off at Wyoming, RI exit. Follow Route 138 East to and over Newport Bridge past Newport Grand. Follow straight thru until you come to stoplight at Route 214 (Valley Road), then take that left. Drive approximately one mile, turning left at KCC sign.
